EDITING STANDARDS:

- Final papers submitted for publication will not exceed 20 pages.

Title and structure of the article

- The first page should include: the title (in Romanian and English or French), the authors' names, details of the position held, professional or academic affiliation and contact addresses. The article should be structured as follows: Introduction, Sections (clearly delimited, with a specific title), Conclusions and Bibliography.

Abstract and keywords

The abstract should be written in Romanian and English or French, and should include the theme and topic of the article, the objectives of the study and the results/applications of the research.

Technical details of formatting

Word format (.doc/.docx), text formatted in left-right/justified alignment, Times New Roman font with 12 point size and line spacing.

Highlighting in the document will be in bold for sections/headings/subheadings and italics for the text.

Quotations should be placed in inverted commas, the original form of the quotation should be respected and the author should be indicated, respecting the specifications for footnotes.

Footnotes should be formatted in left-right/justified alignment, with Times New Roman font size 10 and line spacing. Footnotes should end with a full stop.

Citation rules

• Treatises, monographs:

Author, *Title*, publisher (city, country), year, page.

• Articles published in collective works :

Author, Title, in Author, Title, Publisher (city, country), year, page

• Articles:

Author, 'Title', year, Journal, issue (if any) and pages corresponding to the article.

• Legislation, case law, other documents:

The official citation style will be followed.

• Internet:

The following formula will be used: "the document is available online at the address", url address, with mention of the date of access.

Bibliography/References

The bibliographic references will be numbered and classified in alphabetical order, then chronologically.
